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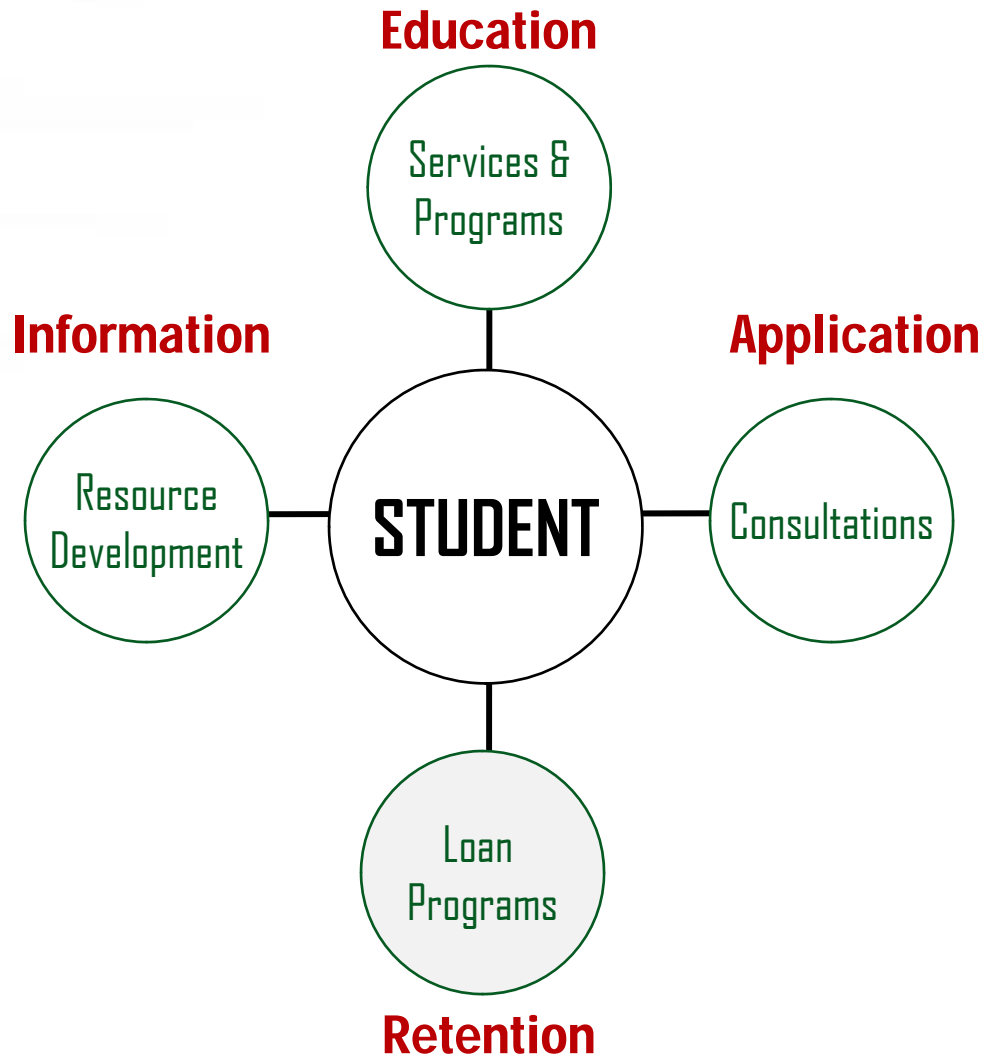

Pre-Approved Credit Card Offers

Calling 1-888-5-OPTOUT (1-888-567-8688) to have your name removed from direct marketing lists. You can do this online at OptOutPreScreen.com, which is the official consumer credit reporting industry opt-out website.

Unsolicited Telemarketing Calls

Stop unsolicited telemarketing calls by registering your telephone numbers online at the National Do Not Call Registry website – www.donotcall.gov. **Your registration will not expire.** Telephone numbers placed on the National Do Not Call Registry will remain on it permanently due to the Do-Not-Call Improvement Act of 2007, which became law in February 2008.
